**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MUSKOGEE, OKLAHOMA, RECOGNIZING AND DECLARING THE SECOND MONDAY IN OCTOBER AS INDIGENOUS PEOPLES DAY IN THE CITY OF MUSKOGEE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Muskogee recognizes that Indigenous Peoples have had an immeasurable impact on the State of Oklahoma and the City of Muskogee; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Muskogee desires to celebrate and honor the significant and rich cultural history of Indigenous Peoples; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Muskogee wants to insure that the traditions, culture and contributions of Indigenous Peoples are recognized for future generations; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Muskogee believes that working together with tribal nation leaders, schools and other governmental entities will ensure that future generations of both native and non-native people will appreciate the rich history and substantial contributions made by Indigenous Peoples to both our community and society as a whole; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MUSKOGEE, OKLAHOMA:**

**THAT** the City of Muskogee hereby declares the second Monday in October as Indigenous Peoples Day.
